### Friday 24<sup>th</sup> May

Boys will arrive at school by 07:30:

Dressed in full Bishops tracksuit, khakis, 175 cap, their sporting kit bag and overnight bag (for those staying over) for the weekend. All boys will be transported on buses sourced by the Bishops transport department to Durbanville Primary School (fully road-worthy and PDP licensed drivers in place as per usual).

The day at Durbanville will look as follows:

- Arrive by 09:00 and attend an assembly where there will be music items and short welcoming speeches (boys performing musical items will be notified).
- Hockey matches will start at 11:30.
- Tennis and Chess matches will start around 11:30; boys will be selected and notified by Mr de Sousa.
- Morning Tea and Lunch will be provided for all boys.
- Golf: boys will be selected depending on their Chess, Tennis and Hockey commitments.

For boys not participating in any sporting activities on Friday, there will be an activity organised. Details to follow. Each boys' personal schedule will be sent to the boys' and parents; this will be sent out closer to the time.
