Tournament Rules:

- 1. U 9 teams may have a maximum of 8 players in the squad. Junior teams may have 12 and senior 14 players in their squads.
- 2. For Under 9 only 6 players may be on the field at any given time. For juniors, 8 and seniors 11 players may only be on the field during the matches. Rolling substitutions apply.
- 3. Under 9 will play quarter field. Juniors will play half field. Seniors will play full field.
- 4. Normal league hockey rules will apply for each age group.
- 5. If teams are level on points after the round robin stage, goal difference, then goals scored, then the result of the round robin match will-be-taken into account in this order. If teams are still level a *shoot out will take place. Each team will have 3*strikers. If the result is still level, a sudden death shoot out will take place.

*Shoot Out rules: A striker will start from the 23m line with the ball and the goalkeeper will start from the base line in his goal box. When the whistle blows, the striker will advance and try score a goal. Normal rules then apply. The attack will-be-deemed dead once the ball is over the base line or is

cleared by the goalkeeper out of the D once carried into the circle or an infringement takes place or a goal is scored. If the goalkeeper infringes a penalty-stroke will-be-awarded. There is a 10 second time limit on each shootout.
