The programme currently offers sport (primarily rugby), academic support (English and Maths), recreational outings and a daily hot meal. VUSA also supports three registered ECD centres in Langa developing numeracy and literacy skills through play.

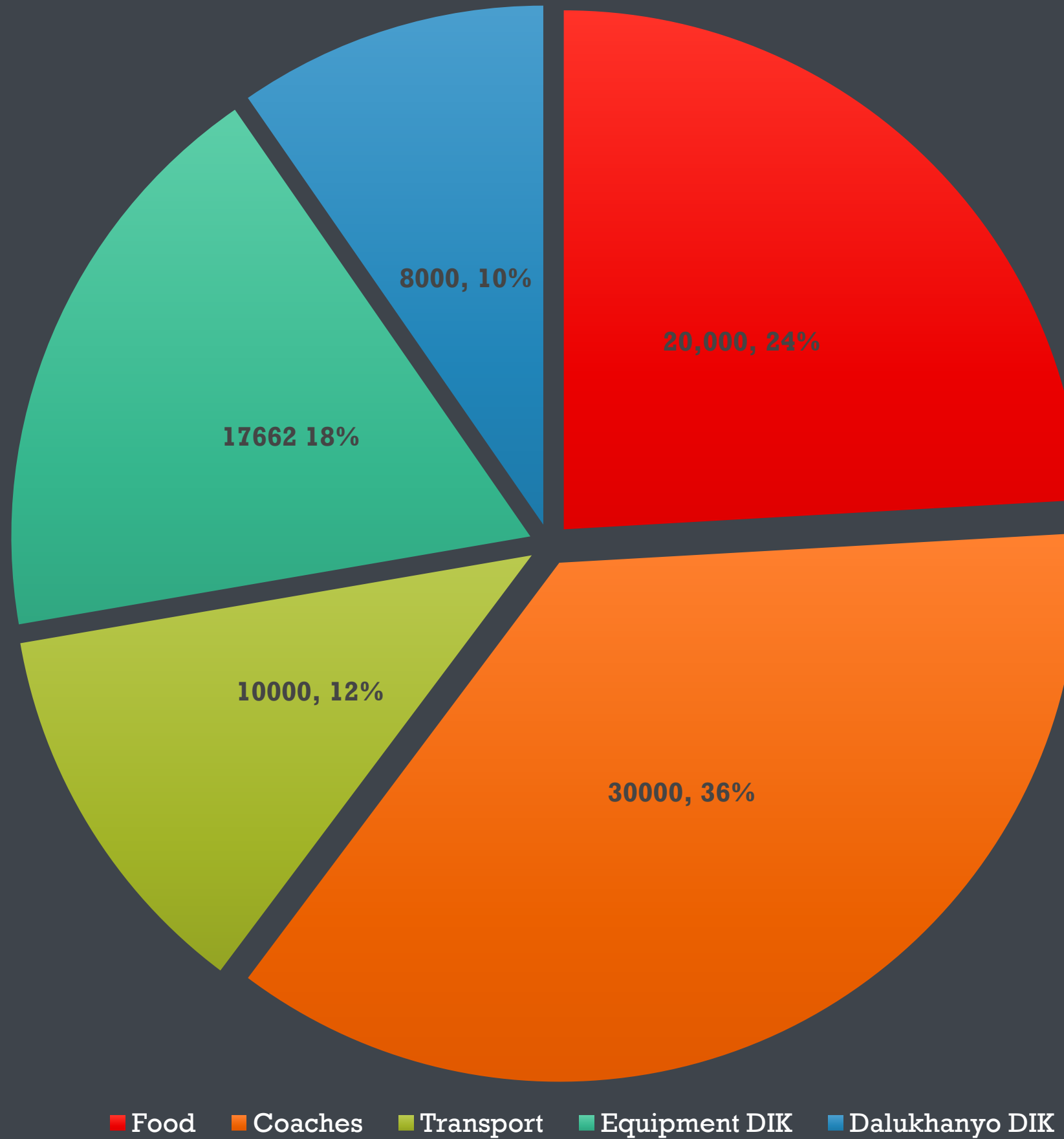

The Vusa programme has a diverse funding streams thereby ensuring it will continue to grow and deliver on its objectives

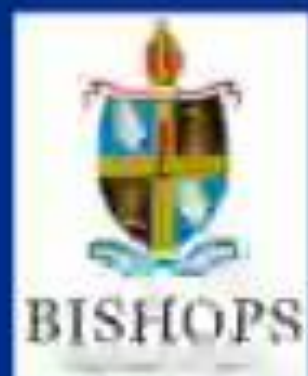
